From Katrineholm: follow signs as above, appearing in road 56.

The last 5 kms the road is a narrow and twisting country lane.

- **Vaccinated according to the SKK rules**

Bring the EU passport or registration papers plus a vaccination certificate to verify age and vaccination status on demand.

Youngster class 15-24 months

Working class, for dogs with a formal working (earthdog) merit

Open class over 2 years old, not for show Champions

Champion class, for show Champions (title won in any country)

Veteran class 8-10 years

Still Going Strong class, 10 years or older

"Come-as-you-are" any age, not in show condition, may have disqualifying faults

Each dog should be entered in only one out of the classes listed above. Age is calculated for the exact date of the show.

The exhibition is held in two rings, both starting at 9:00 am. While the judge is placing in either of the rings, a short break will be made in the other ring.

Dogs awarded HP (honours) are invited to participate in the corresponding challenge class: Best Puppy, Best Veteran/Still Going Strong, Best Dog, Best Bitch.

Please check in the catalogue whether your dog is listed in breeder or progeny class; in this case contact your breeder or the sire's/dam's owner to check if your dog is selected for participation.
